Is SCCA Solo II For You?

The Buccaneer Region offers a very strong Solo II (aka Autocross) program. Currently 11 events are scheduled in the Jacksonville area. Most of these events will take place at the Whitehouse location.

Solo II events test a driver's ability and the car's handling characteristics. Unlike road racing, Solo II competitors go one at a time and race against the clock. At the end of the day if you are the person with the fastest time, you take home the trophy.

The SCCA produces a list of classes and cars that are eligible in each class. There are six different categories that you can race in.

Stock – includes mass produced vehicles able to be used for normal street driving. These cars must compete in their showroom configuration with only minor modifications such as aftermarket shocks, wheels and tires.

Street Prepared – All stock category vehicles are eligible for Street Prepared. You can make additional modifications to



the suspension, ignition, intake and exhaust to further enhance the performance of the vehicle. Internal engine modifications are not allowed, but changes to the bodywork to accommodate larger wheels and tires are permitted.

Prepared Classes A, B, C, D, E and F – This category includes high performance, production based non-street driven vehicles. Cars retain their original design, structure and drive layout. Minimum weights are specified.

Modified – These vehicles are heavily modified specifically for the purpose of competition. Vehicles in this category range from heavily modified production cars to formula cars, single-seat

cars, dunebuggies and kit cars.

Street Touring – This is a local option that allows for sedans (four seaters) with a maximum displacement of 3.1L and normally aspirated. This category is for the popular street cruisers with lowered suspension, air filter systems and wider wheels.

Street Modified – This is another local option class. It is similar to Street Touring except that extensive drivetrain and suspension modifications are allowed.

In addition to these categories go-karts **continued on page 4**

Called to order at 7:10 pm
by **Ted Migchelbrink**

Ted gave an update on the Panhard Motorsports Group. He said they have had financial and personnel set backs, but are looking at April or May to start having school days at the track.

Ted also said that the Savannah Solo program needs a race chair and site. He spoke with the GPA and their board meets on 23 January and may discuss using Hutchinson Island again.

Jacksonville Solo Report

Julius Ashley reported that the financial report

has not changed since the last meeting. Their next event will be 25 January at Whitehouse. **Fred Clark** asked if he had all of the paperwork for the event taken care of. **Julius** said he had the sanctions for the next three events. **Fred C.** told Julius if there is anything he needs from the Board to just let them know.

Julius also reported that the autocross fees have gone up \$0.50. Their upcoming events are 25 January, 22 February, 20 March (school) and 21 March.

Treasurer's Report

The report was given to the Board members.

Track Manager's Report

An estimate for having an FM radio station connected to the PA was passed out. It would not be the same frequency as the radios. **Ted** said there is someone in the SEDiv who is an expert at radios and he will have a discussion with him at the annual meeting. **Larry Buell** commented that he thought having an FM station would reduce the problem. **Mike W.** inquired about the cost of this station verses more speakers and wire. **Larry** also stated that we are already blasting out the neighbors and the FM

radio would be good for the neighbors too.

Estimates for paving more of the infield were also passed out. The first will be for 7720'. **Richard McCloy** said he will have them do that first and see what kind of work they do. If the work is good then he will have them pave 4340' of the paddock road. There was also talk about paving the false grid. **Judy Corbitt** commented that paving the false grid would make it very hot. **Richard** reported that the bathrooms had been painted on the inside.

They are also looking at having a three pads paved just past the false grid for the tire people. This will relieve some of the congestion where Goodyear usually parks. Kuhmo has agreed to pay for their pad. The Region will have to pay for Goodyear's since they paid for their spot years ago.

Fred C. moved to proceed with making parking pads after making sure it is okay with the tire people
Mike W. seconded the motion
Passes unanimously

Race Chair Report

Faye Craft reported that she has mailed out 147 information packets for the drivers school. They have

received 25 entries already. **Russ Smith** inquired about getting the information off of the Website. He said when he goes to the Website he gets the Rocky Mountain Region website. This started about two weeks ago. **Mike W.** said the link from SCCA's Website is what takes you to the Rocky Mountain site. **Ted** asked everyone who has Website issues to e-mail Karen and explain the problem to her. Then she will look into the problem. He then stated that Robert Frazier feels like he is being pushed out of the Race Chair position.

Faye commented that she is doing the paperwork and Robert will take care of things at the track.

Competition Chair Report

Fred C. asked if it would be possible to advertise the open-wheel event with other Region newsletters. **Lindsay Fox** said that would not be a problem. **Fred C.** then inquired about the beer wagon and what happened to it. **Kaye McCloy** explained that we have to have a license and someone has to be responsible. So it looks like the wagon is gone forever. Everyone who rents the track needs to know this. **Fred C.** also said he was still waiting to

hear from the C and D Sports Racers to find out about having an enduro at the Peach State event in September.

Old Business

Drivers School – Russ said that Fred Schmucker has received e-mails complaining about racers having to register for the entire school if they've already done the first half of the school. There was much discussion on this issue. If someone has attended an SCCA school then it will be assumed they have been through the classroom portion. If they have only attended an SCCA accredited school then they still need to sit through the classroom portion. **Faye** also commented that we will need to find someone to work

registration.

New Business

Sound Station Improvements – Larry stated that the current set up for sound does not keep papers and equipment dry and it can be very hot and cold. He would like to see the old SOM building moved. **Fred C.** asked about the protection needed. **Ted** asked about making improvements to what is there. **Fred C.** asked to table this issue until the next meeting.

Tom Nehl National – Ted said he is already receiving requests for information. Steve Johnson will be at the event. They need to look into getting hotel rooms because that is the weekend before St. Patrick's Day.

Website – Karen reported that in November we had 1144 hits and in December we had 2054 hits.

Secretary – Lindsay announced that she will be moving and can no longer be the Region secretary. **Judy** volunteered to be secretary.

Open House – Judy asked that everyone start thinking about the open house and bringing their cars.
